Minister's Report

- Jeff reported that the Lifelong Learning Team will become the Discipleship Team, and it will be chaired by Alan Taback. Its purpose is to work to promote and oversee new endeavors to help the congregation make and raise up disciples who want to learn more about Jesus as Lord and Savior. Youth programs and Sunday school, previously under the purview of Lifelong Learning, will be overseen by this new team.
- Jeff reported that he is applying to Classis for a grant in the amount of approximately \$3000. This money would go to the Discipleship Team and be designated for outreach programming. A decision from Classis is expected by the end of October.

• The chairs of Sinterklaas are recommending that 80% of the profits from the event be used to help fund the outdoor lighting project. The recommendation was accepted, voted on, and approved by Consistory.
